Aim:

The course aims to provide participants with the knowledge and understanding to confidently use the latest bulk fill composite materials for optimal stress free results. By using innovative advanced techniques that can be utilised by every Clinician, this course will demonstrate how easy it is to switch to an amalgam free environment with minimal outlay and comply with the EU amalgam phasedown.

- Understand the types of bonding systems used in conjunction with composite technology.

- Gain practical experience in the techniques of freehand composite placements to achieve aesthetic restorations in the molar and pre-molar region.

- Recognise how you can make your restorations affordable both in time and financially for the patient and clinician.
- Recognise the pitfalls of composite placement and be able to trouble shoot.
