Aim: To provide an overview on how fibre reinforced composites can be used to restore the periodontally compromised dentition

3. Treat the periodontally compromised patients effectively and to stabilize their dentitions with fibre reinforced composite splints and restorations
4. Use a natural tooth as a pontic in combination with periodontal splinting
