Paul HR Wilson BSc (Hons), BDS(Glasgow-1997), MSc(Lond), FDS RCPS (Glasg), FDS (RestDent)RCPS (Glasg), DipDSed(Lond)

Paul HR Wilson grew up in the North East of Scotland and graduated from the University of Glasgow with Honours in Medical Biochemistry and Dental Surgery in 1997. Part of his undergraduate training was completed at the Universite Louis Pasteur, Strasbourg, funded by an Erasmus Scholarship, and he was awarded the prestigious James Whitelaw Prize for Best Student in his final year. After working in general dental practice and senior house officer posts, in 2000 he underwent postgraduate specialist training at Great Ormond Street Hospital, Guy's & St Thomas' Dental Institute, King's College London and the University of Alberta Canada, completing Consultant training in 2005. He was awarded the TC White Scholarship of the Royal College of Physicians & Surgeons of Glasgow in 2005, an AstraZeneca Scholarship in 2006, and won the GlaxoSmithKline Fellowship of the Royal Society of Alberta, Canada, in 2006. He is a Fellow of the Royal College of Physicians & Surgeons of Glasgow (FDSRCPS 2000) and passed the Intercollegiate Fellowship Examination in Restorative Dentistry of the surgical Royal Colleges of the United Kingdom and Ireland (FDS RestDent 2006).

Paul HR Wilson was Consultant in Restorative Dentistry and Honorary Senior Clinical Lecturer at the University of Bristol Dental School and the Royal United Hospital Bath, from 2006 until 2013. At Bristol Dental Hospital he was Lead Consultant for oral rehabilitation for the South-West Head and Neck Cancer Network and for dental trauma. He is currently locum Consultant in Restorative Dentistry at Aberdeen Dental Hospital, 2 days per week.

Paul HR Wilson's clinic at 13 Circus runs 3 full days per week on Mondays, Thursdays and Fridays, and he has a satellite private clinic at BMI Bath Clinic for consultations and treatment under general anaesthesia.

He also works as a Clinical Lecturer for the MSc in Dental Implantology, University of Bristol. In addition, he acts as an expect Dental Witness for the General Dental Council in NHS England and Wales and several independent law firms.

Jon graduated from the University of Bristol in 2004. After completing vocational training, he worked in Carlisle in General Practice. Jon relocated back to the south-west in 2006 and continued working in General Practice in Bath and in 2009 was awarded a Diploma in Endodontic Practice with merit after two years of further postgraduate training at Bart's and the London Hospital.

Soon after this, he embarked upon four years of formal specialist training in the field of Endodontics at Guy's Hospital. As part of his specialist training, he was awarded a Master of Clinical Dentistry degree in Endodontics with distinction at King's College, London whilst also attaining the Membership in Endodontics from the Royal College of Surgeons of Edinburgh.

Jon is also a part-time Clinical Instructor for the MSc in Endodontics at King's College, London. He has published clinical articles and is a reviewer for the International Endodontic Journal.

Jon has been accepting endodontic referrals locally for many years and is a General Dental Council registered Specialist in Endodontics.
