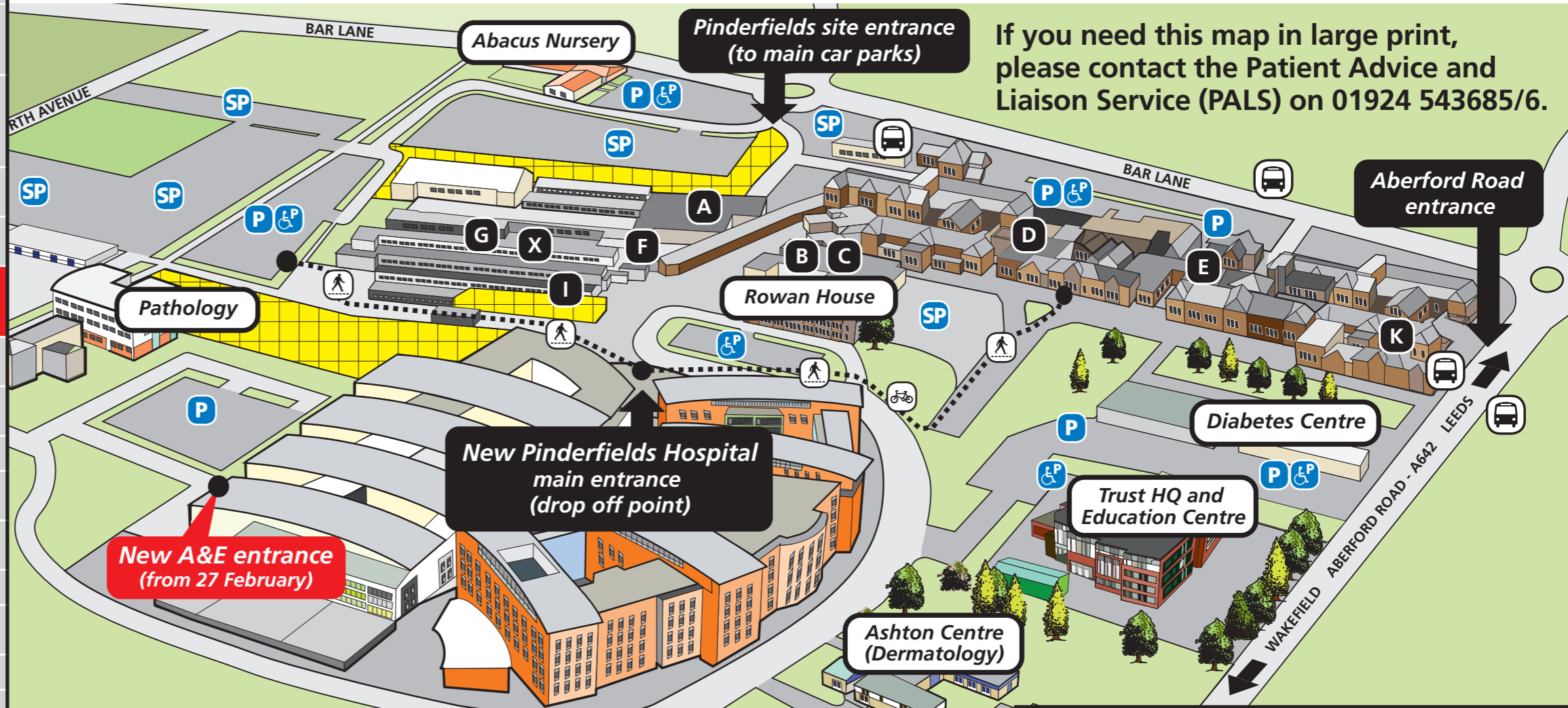

From 25 February to 8 March, the services listed left will move into our new Pinderfields Hospital. The list shows the date when each service will move and its location until then. All other services are already open in the new hospital.

Surgery patients

Surgery patients who are on a ward in the existing hospital before 27 February will stay on that ward until they are either discharged or moved to another ward as appropriate. **Staff will advise patients and relatives in advance of any move to another ward.**

From 27 February to 4 March, patients admitted for emergency surgery will go to Ward 33 in the new hospital.

For patients being admitted for planned surgery, this will go ahead according to the details in your patient letter.
