

HEEYH Internal Medicine Stage 1 and 2- Suggested e-LfH Modules to support Curriculum Presentations and Conditions

The scope of Internal Medicine is broad and cannot be encapsulated by a finite list of presentations and conditions. The Internal Medicine Stage 1 and 2 curriculum lists several presentations and conditions that trainees should develop the knowledge, skills and attitudes around managing. For each condition/presentation, trainees will need to be familiar with such aspects as aetiology, epidemiology, clinical features, investigation, management and prognosis. Some conditions will be encountered frequently, and trainees will be confident in their management. Below are some suggested e-LfH modules to support trainees to develop their knowledge of conditions and presentations they may be less familiar with or encounter less frequently. These modules are not mandatory nor does a trainee need to complete them all but can be used to evidence learning and curriculum completion.
