Who Should Attend?

The course is aimed at Registered Dental Therapists.

Aim: To improve delegates' knowledge of, and ability to, provide dental care to children with dental caries, including the use of the Hall Technique.

Learning Outcomes:

By the end of the event delegates will be able to:

- Diagnose childhood (Paediatric) dental caries, and explain the role of dental radiographs.
- Complete an accurate caries risk assessment in children and provide appropriate preventive care.
- Formulate an effective treatment plan for children with dental caries, in accordance with direct access legislation.
- Demonstrate use of the Hall technique to place Preformed Metal Crowns.

Teaching and learning will consist of interactive lectures, case based discussions and 'hands-on' practice of the Hall Technique on phantom head models.
