Who Should Attend?

The course is aimed at Registered General Dental Practitioners (GDP's)

Aim:

To develop a logical and predictable approach to endodontics, using modern endodontic techniques. The course will help participants develop a better understanding of modern endodontic techniques, by having an improved knowledge and hands on experience in the practical sessions.

Learning Outcomes:

By the end of the event delegates will be able to:

- Describe the current concepts of modern endodontic practices.
- Use magnification to aid in visualisation of root canal treatment
- Prepare access cavities, being mindful of conservation of tooth tissue and straight line access.
- Describe the normal anatomical location of canals.
- Discuss techniques which will aid safe and predictable negotiation of root canal space.
- Undertake simple chemo-mechanical rotary preparation techniques.
- Undertake obturation techniques that complement the preparation.

Course Fee and Booking Details

The course fee for this event is **£200.00** per person which includes practical sessions in the Phantom Head Suite, a sandwich lunch and refreshments.
