

# Medical Emergencies for the Dental Team

Improving health and care through education

Medical Emergencies are now one of the GDC's core CPD subjects & all individuals registered with them are obliged to fulfil these requirements. Most practices now do their CPR training "in-house" but there are other medical problems that also need to be revised & rehearsed from time to time. This course is designed to fill in these gaps.

CPR will not be covered on this course.

## Course Aims

To revise & update all common medical emergencies in general dental practice, as advised by the Resuscitation Council (UK). These are:

- Asthma
- Anaphylaxis
- Cardiac emergencies including angina & myocardial infarction
- Epileptic seizures
- Hypoglycaemia
- Syncope
- Choking & aspiration
- Adrenal insufficiency

By the end of the course, participants should be more confident in diagnosing & handling these emergencies. The session is open to all members of the dental team but particularly those registered with the GDC who need to fulfil their CPD requirements.
