**Aim:** To help practitioners improve their tooth preparation skills to produce more successful adhesive and conventional coverage restorations.

- Discuss the principles of extra-coronal tooth preparation including the importance of retention and resistance form
- Explain the preparations required for a metal ceramic crown, full gold crown, dentine bonded crown, labial ceramic veneer, Emax Crown and an adhesive gold onlay.
- Use putty matrices as an aid to improving their extra-coronal tooth preparations.
- Apply the different design features discussed to their tooth preparations, including metal ceramic crowns, full gold crowns, dentine bonded crowns, labial ceramic veneers, adhesive gold onlays and Emax restorations.
- Appreciate the importance of an accurate master impression/locating impression/jaw registration when treatment planning and providing fixed prosthodontics.
