# **Certificate in Dental Implant Nursing (Course outline)**

#### Summary

This course is aimed at dental nurses who are required to undertake the skills required during the placement of implants and their related restorations.

This course will run over a 12 month period. The study days will include all the theoretical instruction and practical experience needed to fulfil the NEBDN syllabus.

## Entry

To be eligible for the course you must:

- Have the support of your employer in completion of the Record of Competence and be able to commit to 100% attendance on the given course dates
- Be registered with the GDC

## The Award

In order to achieve the award you will have to successfully complete: -

- A Record of Competence
- A written paper (1 hour 30 minutes multiple choice and extended matching questions)

# Record of Competence

This is designed to provide a record of activities completed to facilitate specific learning experience.

The Record of Competence consists of:-

### Part A: Practical Competence Assessment Sheets (PCAS)

## Surgical procedures

Candidates must complete x 10 evidence of their involvement in 10 surgical fixture placement procedures (1 patient could have two or more placements) and x 5 surgical augmentation procedures involving hard or soft tissues, which may be the same as fixture placements

#### Restorative cases

Candidates must complete a minimum of 15 PCAS to provide evidence of their involvement in various stages of a range of types of implants.

X5 restorative abutment connections, x1 restorative crown, x1 restorative bridge, x 1 restorative denture and x 7 restorative various

## Maintenance of an implant

Candidates must complete a minimum of 10 PCAS to provide evidence of instructions given to patients on the maintenance of an implant

### Part B

## **Expanded Case Studies (1500-2000 words each)**

Candidates must choose x 2 patients for the production of detailed case studies covering:-

- o The surgical phase of implant treatment
- The restorative phase of implant treatment

#### Part C

## **Directly Observed Clinical Skills assessments (DOCS)**

To enable you to complete your record of competence you must demonstrate your capability and evidence in relation to the following: -

- o X 5 intra-oral and x 5 extra-oral cases of clinical photography
- X 5 mixing impression materials and assisting with the loading of impression trays

These activities will be assessed by a suitably qualified witness with expertise n the skill being assessed. They must be registered with a recognised professional body

#### Part D

## **Supplementary Outcomes**

The candidate must complete each of the supplementary outcomes to a level deemed satisfactory by the course provider. The supplementary outcomes will allow the candidate to demonstrate knowledge and understanding of areas of the syllabus in which they may not be able to gain in clinical experience.

- X 2 sets of intra and extra oral clinical photographs
- Recording of continuing professional development relating to dental implant nursing

## Examination date(s) set by the NEBDN

The NEBDN set the final examination date, this will be either the 3<sup>rd</sup> Friday in September or the 3<sup>rd</sup> Friday in March dependent upon the start date of your programme.
