### **Who Should Attend?**

The course is aimed at qualified General Dental Practitioners (GDPs).

It is also open to Dental Technicians and Dental Nurses with an interest in this area.

**Aim:** To help practitioners improve their knowledge and application of partial and complete removable dentures. It is an interactive session of seminars and case based discussions, covering the contemporary management of partially and completely edentulous patients with removable prostheses.

### **Learning Outcomes:**

By the end of the event, delegates will be able to:

- Summarize the principles of partial and complete denture design
- Describe which impression and occlusal registration techniques may be appropriate when managing a removable prosthodontic patient.
- List the design features of overlay/overdentures.
- Clinically manage a patient with combination syndrome predictably.
- Rehabilitate a gagging patient with a training plate.
- Describe the principles of duplicate and immediate denture prosthodontics.
- Describe the attachment systems of basic implant retained overdentures.
- Recall that patients with palatal defects can be rehabilitated with obturators and need referral to a specialist centre.
