

## Frequently Asked Questions

### Where will the sessions take place?

All sessions will take place in Education Centre One at Royal Preston Hospital. Please report to reception where you will be instructed as to which room to go to.

### When will the sessions take place?

There are four face to face taught sessions in total. Sessions begin at 9:15am promptly and will finish between 3 and 4pm approximately, dependant on the amount of work to be covered each session. Lunch will be from 12:30-1:00pm.

### Where can I park?

There is an onsite car park, in front of the Education Centre which you should be able to use. To be able to use this you will need to provide the course administrator with further details should your application be successful.

### Who will lead each session?

Glenys Bridges of 'Glenys Bridges & Partners Practice Pathways' will be teaching your face to face sessions.

### How much is the course?

This course has been subsidised by Health Education England so has the total cost to delegates of £90. By submitting an application, you agree to attendance at all sessions. **If for any reason you are unable to complete the course, you will be liable for the full cost of the course which would be a further £650.**

### How does it work?

This course is taught in a 'Blended Learning' style, comprising of 4 face to face taught sessions, submit ion of assignments online and independent study. Telephone consultations for support and/or tutorials is also available.

As you cannot receive verifiable education hours from 2 providers for the same course, Glenys Bridges will be providing you with an Enhanced CPD certificate for this qualification. Upon completion you will receive 130 hours of Enhanced CPD with GDC development outcome B.
