DIRECTIONS & PARKING

MANDEC is built on the roof of the Dental Hospital and has its OWN ENTRANCE in Bridgeford Street. <u>PLEASE NOTE</u>: Access is <u>NOT</u> available through the Dental Hospital Patient Entrance – the MANDEC small entrance door is to the left of this. On entering the building take the lift or stairs to the 3rd floor.

Located within the Manchester University Campus, the Dental Education Centre is just minutes away from Manchester City Centre and British Rail mainline stations. All approach routes are clearly signposted Universities.

By Road

From the North (M6): Leave M6 at J19 taking the third exit at the roundabout onto Chesrer Road A566. Continue straight ahead onto the A50. At the major roundabout bear right onto M56. Follow the M56 until it turns into the A5103 signposted for the city centre. Take the A5103 into the centre of Manchester until you reach a major roundabout with an overpass. Take the 3rd exit at the roundabout on the Mancunian Way A57 lower level. At the next roundabout take the 2nd exit. At the next roundabout take the 3rd exit onto Cambridge Street (which becomes Higher Cambridge Street). Straight through the traffic lights at the crossroad – the entrance to Booth Street West car park (D) is the first left after the Hyatt Regency Hotel.

From M62 (eastbound): Take the M62 west to Manchester. Leave M62 at J12 onto the Eccles bypass. Continue straight ahead onto the A57. At the next roundabout take the 2nd exit. At the next roundabout take the 3rd exit onto Cambridge Street (which becomes Higher Cambridge Street). Straight through the traffic lights at the crossroad – the entrance to Booth Street West car park (D) is the first left after the Hyatt Regency Hotel.

From the South (M6): Leave M6 at junction 19 and turn right onto the A556 for 3 miles. Follow signs for Manchester Airport and join the M56. Continue along M56 (which continues as A5103 Princess Road). Continue for a further 4 miles (6km) before turning right into B5219 (Moss Lane East) at the Brewery. At the traffic lights, turn left onto Lloyd Street North, which continues onto Higher Cambridge Street. The Booth Street West multi storey car park (D) can be seen on the right (immediately after the University Dental Hospital), the entrance is the first right after the car park and before the Hyatt Regency Hotel.

PARKING

Please note: Booth Street West car park is chargeable. Access is from HIGHER CAMBRIDGE STREET. SATNAV postcode M15 6PB.
