Who Should Attend?

The course is aimed at all members of the dental team.

Aim:

This is an interactive course provided to all members of the dental team to allow them to manage common emergencies that may present in practice as part of a team. Delegates will be given information on the management of medical emergencies and how these may present in practice and then utilise this knowledge in small groups to manage emergency events.

Delegates who successfully complete the course will be provided with BLS certification for a year

Learning Outcomes:

By the end of the event delegates will be able to:

- Recall the common medical emergencies that present in practice and how these are managed by the dental team.
- List the equipment and drugs required to manage common medical emergencies
- Perform basic life support (with airway adjuncts) on a simulated patient
- Manage a medical emergency as part of team in a simulated environment

This programme qualifies for 6 hours of verifiable CPD
