2 Presentation sessions 10am - 12 & 2pm - 4pm Monday 22nd June 2020

Guidance

10 minute slot (8 mins presentation, 2 mins questions - similar to most scientific meetings).

5 slides maximum to present and summarise. (You will be cut off if you run overtime).

Visuals should be simple and bold.

Avoid submitting compactly packed, high word-count slides.

You will be able to talk over the presentation to embellish the information.

Discuss any cases with the consultant whose patient you are presenting.

There should be no patient identifiable information.

Present numerical data in the form of graphs, rather than tables (graphs make trends in the data much more evident). If data must be presented in table-form **Keep it Simple**.

Organise your presentation into subdivisions with the key learning points as the focus

Please identify your presentation with your name and host trust/institution at beginning and end.

The screen share will be done centrally (this seems to be more stable than everyone sharing from their own device.

This will be on MS Teams platform and you will be sent an invite.

You can share the invitation with your ES and work colleagues.
