ORAL HEALTH AND APPLICATION OF FLUORIDE VARNISH FOR DENTAL NURSES

This higher education course is certificated by The University of Central Lancashire (UCLan) and delivered in partnership with Health Education North West and Colgate[®].

The aim of the course is to prepare a GDC registered dental nurse to achieve a 20 credit degree module in evidence-based and effective oral health advice and the application of fluoride varnish

- 4 full days of classroom sessions (held between 9am and 5pm)
- 200 learning hours over a 12 week period
- Students require a computer and internet access to complete e-learning elements of study
- Students are required to see 35 patients to complete a clinical record, this work must be directly supervised bt a dentist.
- Students are assessed by submission of a written portfolio and a Direct Observation of Practice (DOPs)
- £125.00 registration fee payable by student's employer plus £25 (local charge)
