

Safeguarding Level 2 Children and Vulnerable Adults

Level 2 courses are aimed at designated practice safeguarding leads or other team members who have greater involvement with child protection in the practice. If you are working towards a senior safeguarding role in your organisation e.g. Safeguarding Champion, Designated Person etc. then this course will assist you.

Aim

To equip staff with the skills and knowledge to be able to identify, respond to, and report safeguarding concerns in children and vulnerable adults in dental practice

Objectives

- Be able to identify what is a safeguarding concern in dental practice in children and vulnerable adults
- Be able to respond appropriately to patients and their parents/carers when there is a safeguarding concern
- Be able to share information safely and legally
- Be able to access help for a child/vulnerable adult when you have a safeguarding concern

- To increase the confidence and knowledge in identifying safeguarding concerns in children and vulnerable adults,
- Know how to respond to patients and their parents/carers about whom there is a concern and to make clear the appropriate reporting pathways for professionals
