

# Safeguarding Level 2 Children and Vulnerable Adults

Level 2 courses are aimed at designated practice safeguarding leads or other team members who have greater involvement with child protection in the practice. If you are working towards a senior safeguarding role in your organisation e.g. Safeguarding Champion, Designated Person etc. then this course will assist you.

## Aim

To equip staff with the skills and knowledge to be able to identify, respond to, and report safeguarding concerns in children and vulnerable adults in dental practice

## Safeguarding Children

- Child development / National assessment framework (attachment theory)
- Child Protection Process (Working Together 2013)
- Joint investigation process & roles/responsibilities of professionals involved
- Perspective of child & family involved in CP process
- Knowledge of CP conferences & role of independent reviewing officer
- Knowledge of LSCB's

## Safeguarding Adults at Risk

- Understand roles & responsibilities of others under Safeguarding Adults at Risk Procedures
- Understand the investigation process from alert to referral, planning meeting & protection plan
- Understanding emotional aspect of making a decision for another who lacks capacity
- Demonstrate an awareness of the main principles of the Mental Capacity Act 2005 Best interest principles
- Understand the requirements of the Deprivation of Liberty Safeguards
- Other safeguarding arrangements eg MAPPA & MARAC and National Child and Domestic Abuse Disclosure schemes
- Knowledge of SAP boards
- Referral pathway - meeting structure – timescales
