Aim: To provide an oral medicine update for dental hygienists and dental therapists.

Course Objectives:

By the end of the event delegates will:

- Recognise the normal and abnormal anatomical features of the oral mucosal/oral cavity.
- Describe how abnormalities of the oral mucosa / oral cavity can occur.
- Demonstrate how to undertake a comprehensive extra and intraoral examination.
- Recognise clinical presentation and management of suspicious oral lesions including premalignancy and oral cancer.
- Refer patients following the correct referral pathways with regard to medico-legal responsibility.

The course designers are aware that the demands of general dental practice and the recent introduction of Direct Access may impact on patient care.

Delegates will receive a demonstration on how to undertake a comprehensive, yet efficient, extra and intraoral examination. There will be discussion on suspicious oral lesions and direction will be given on correct referral pathways with regard to medico-legal responsibility.
