Who Should Attend?

The course is aimed at qualified General Dental Practitioners (GDP'S). It meets the new GDC requirements for enhanced CPD.

Aim: The course will give an understanding of the Index of Orthodontic Treatment Need (IOTN) in both its dental health and aesthetic components. It will provide practitioners with the skills to assess their patients' orthodontic needs with regard to appropriate referral for diagnosis, treatment and specialist opinions. It will also include a practical hands-on element to allow delegates to practice their IOTN skills

Learning Outcomes:

By the end of the event delegates will be able to:

- Undertake an IOTN assessment on patients using DHC and AC
- Explain the use of IOTN to patients
- Justify referral need to patients based on IOTN outcome
