

How To Find Us

Our vast greenfield site offers wonderful views of mountains and sea, yet the campus is just a 5 minute drive from the M6 motorway and ten minutes from the main West Coast railway with direct services to Manchester, Leeds, London and Scotland.

By Road

Leave the M6 motorway at junction 33 and take the A6 towards Lancaster. Pass through Galgate village and after 1.5 miles at the second set of traffic lights, turn right up the main University drive.

By Train

There are direct rail links between Lancaster and London, Birmingham, Leeds, Manchester, Oxford and major cities in Scotland. A journey to London only takes two and a half hours.

By Air

From Manchester International airport, take the M56 motorway at junction 5 and join the M6 motorway at junction 20a (north to Preston and Lancaster). Follow the directions in the 'By Road' section. A direct rail link runs between Manchester airport and Lancaster.

By Bus/Bike

We have a dedicated University bus service and a traffic-free cycle route linking the campus to the outskirts of the city.
