Aims-

This course will provide the practical and theoretical knowledge and skills needed in order for DCPs to competently take impressions for patients to the prescription of a dentist.

Outcomes - on completion of the practical & theory session delegates will

- 1. Check patient's medical history and consent form
- 2. Check prescriptions for patient for impression requested
- 3. Prepare the surgery and patient for impression taking and wax bite registration
- 4. Select and prepare materials to be used for the taking of dental impressions
- 5. Use a safe technique to take accurate impressions of the patient's jaws and register the bite to an appropriate standard
- 6. Be able to manage any complications that might occur during the procedure
- 7. Ensure continuity of care for the patients.

On completion of theory and practical session delegates will be issued with a log book in which to record impressions on 10 patients under the direct supervision of a dental surgeon.

The supervising dental surgeon will be required to record reflective comments on the performance of the DCP and provide a summative report on completion of 10 cases.
