Aim: This course will provide the practical and theoretical knowledge and skills needed in order for DCP's to competently take impressions for patients to the prescription of a dentist.

Objectives: By the end of the course participants will be able to:

1. Check patients medical history and consent from patients
2. Check prescriptions for patient for impression
3. Prepare the surgery and patient for impression taking and bite registration
4. Select and prepare materials to be used for the taking of dental impressions
5. Use a safe technique to take accurate impressions of the patients jaws and register the bite
6. Be able to manage any complications that might occur during the procedure
7. Ensure continuity of care for the patients.
