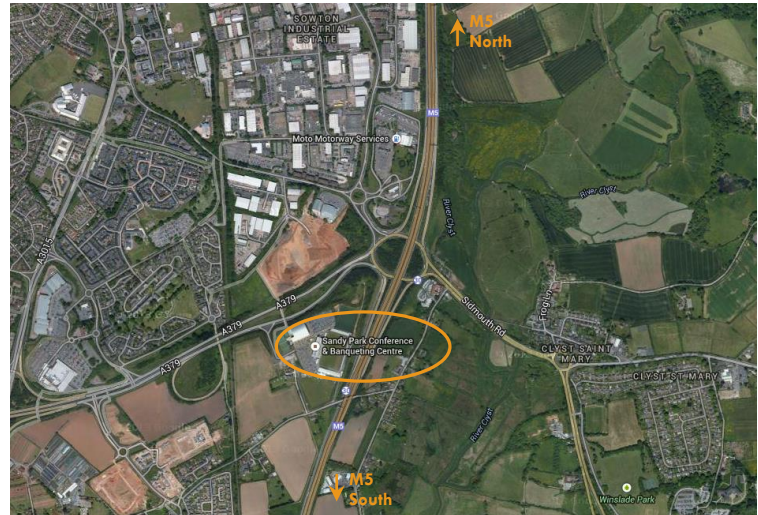
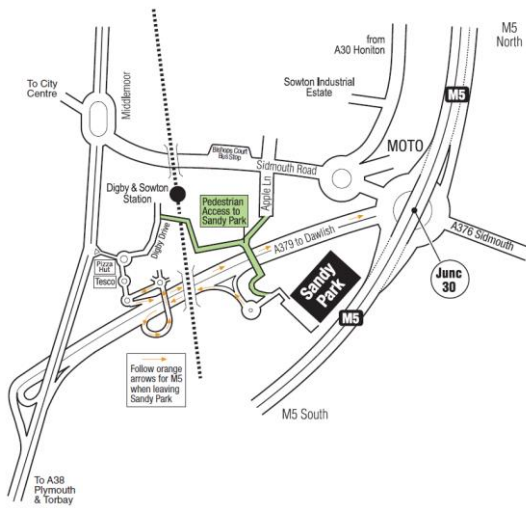




DIRECTIONS



Please note our postcode is not identified by some Satellite Navigation Systems

From the M5 motorway junction 30 roundabout take the exit signed "A379 Exeter and Dawlish" and Sandy Park entrance is signed off on the left after 1/4 mile

PARKING

Sandy Park is delighted to provide an extended car park boasting over 500 spaces

We are working with Premier Park who operate an Automatic Plate Recognition (ANPR) system whereby all vehicle registrations will be captured on arrival and departure by camera.

- All visitors will need to enter their vehicle registration number at one of the machines in the car park
- There is no need to display the receipt in the vehicle once paid
- Visitors can top up at a machine or by [RingGO](#) if overstayed

The following car parking charges will apply:

Up to 1 hour	£1.00
Up to 5 hours	£2.00
Up to 14 hours	£4.00
Up to 24 hours	£6.00

In addition to the on-site meters, visitors to Sandy Park can pay for parking in advance online or via the mobile app [RingGO](#) - please find details on following page

- If you've got an iPhone or Android handset, you can download and use the RingGo app to register and pay for your parking.
- You can call the standard rate telephone number 020 3046 0020 (shown on signs on the machines), at the time you want to park.
- If you want to save time, you can register in advance either through the apps or the [myRingGo website](#), where you can also find out more about using the service.
- As well as being convenient, If you're running late or simply need a bit longer, there's no need to worry – just top up your parking wherever you are by using the service again.

The optional RingGo text reminders also help. These notify you 10 minutes before your parking time is due to run out, leaving you time to either extend your stay or return to your car (10p per reminder).

PAY ON ARRIVAL

There are 7 Pay & Display (coin only) machines on site, and information on paying by ringgo is also on each machine.

GREEN TRAVEL PLAN

By Rail – The nearest rail station is Exeter Digby Sowton - 15 minute walk (0.7 miles approx)

Exeter Digby Sowton is on the main Exeter to Exmouth line. Exeter St David's is 4 miles away and you can catch a train from there to Exeter Digby Sowton. When you get off the train, you will see a sign in front of you saying "Sandy Park Rugby Stadium" to the left, follow the path until you reach another sign directing you to turn right. At the end of this path, there is a blue sign directing you to turn left. Halfway along this path, you turn right and walk across the bridge

Alternatively, Exeter's two main rail stations, **St David's** and **Central** are located approximately 5 miles from Sandy Park. Taxis are available at both stations with an approximate journey time of 15 minutes

By Bus – Service 52 A, B or C (Exeter to Sidmouth)

Arriving at Bishops Court bus stop, walk across the road and up Apple Lane. At the end of Apple Lane, there is a pathway signposted "Sandy Park Rugby Stadium", at the top of the path turn left and walk across the bridge

Park and Ride:

There is a Park and Ride service (PR4) in Sidmouth Road. If you take this service from the City Centre, you can then following the pedestrian directions above for the Service 52 as this park and ride service is located at Bishops Court

There is also a bus service from the RD & E Hospital to the Digby Park & Ride (PR3). This service is located by Exeter Digby Sowton Railway Station - see above for pedestrian directions

Cycle – Sandy Park is on a main cycle route and can be easily reached from all directions. There are cycle racks on site where you can leave your bike
