- — Revisit hand hygiene

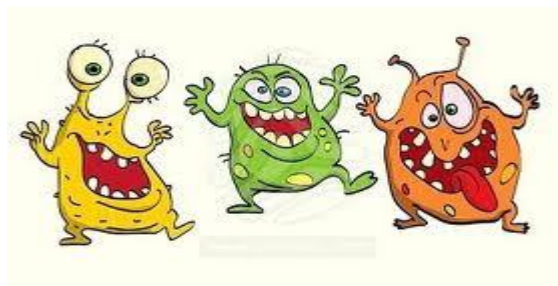
