AIMS-

The aim of the course is to develop the learners ability to recognise, asses and manage medical emergencies- adult and paediatric- in the primary dental setting..

OUTCOMES-

- <u>1-</u> To provide training in how to perform an urgent care assessment of an ill patient.
- **<u>2-</u>** To outline processes and procedures to recognise, manage and where required provide basic and intermediate life support for medical emergencies.
- <u>3-</u> To outline the emergency drugs and equipment that should be held by dental surgeries.
- <u>4-</u> To explain the team approach to medical emergencies.

Learning outcomes-

- <u>1-</u> Identify severe medical events which require urgent hospital admission.
- <u>2-</u> Recognise, manage and provide basic and intermediate life support for medical emergencies in line with the UK Resuscitation Council Guidelines.
