### Eligibility

- This is open to anyone who is not on a specialist training programme and is not a specialist or consultant.
- Dentists, DCPS, undergraduates and postgraduates may apply.
- One presenting author (co-authors to be acknowledged where applicable)
- Member of the BSPD (can join, if not already a member in good standing)

Please submit:

1. Title of the Abstract
2. Abstract text of no more than 250 words outlining your chosen topic
3. Name, job title and membership status of presenting author
