The course description is below:

- a. Fit test training course delivered by Fit2Fit accredited fit tester and is a Fit2Fit approved course.
- b. This course only covers disposable FFP3/FFP2/N95 and reusable half mask respirators.
- c. This course will provide education and training, in line with Fit2Fit guidance on fit testing.
- d. There is a 2 ½ hours online learning aspect of this course and a small theory test that will need completing prior to the face to face aspect of this course.
- e. The face to face aspect is ½ day and covers the practical aspect of fit testing.
- f. This course provides training to allow a delegate to become competent at fit testing, the course itself will not provide you with a certified fit test on the day.

Please note NHS England regional commissioning team will be collecting details of those trained to carry out fit testing. This information will be used by the regional commissioning team to assess the coverage we have in the region and where any potential gaps are. This data will not be shared without prior consent.

Further fit test training courses will be commissioned shortly and will be added to MaxCourse in due course.
