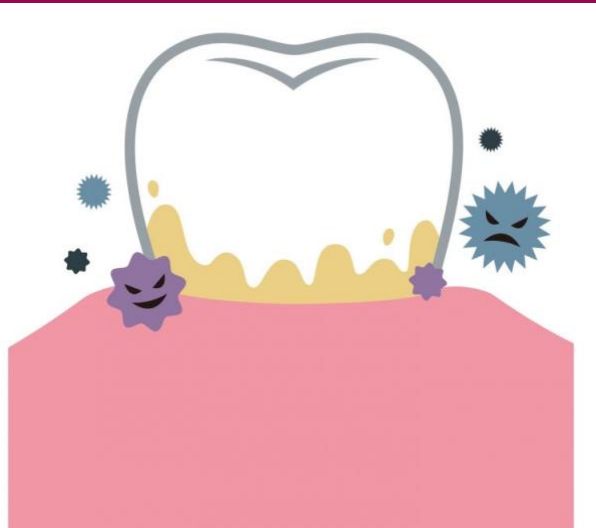


Certificate in Measuring & Recording Plaque for Dental Care Professionals
