



Paediatric Dental Nurse Training Programme

Health Education England, Yorkshire & The Humber are delighted to be working with a local educational provider to be able to bring you a new course in Paediatric Dental Nursing.

This blended, online course aims to provide dental nurses with knowledge and understanding to support the NHS Level 2 programme in primary care. It has been developed by the School of Dental Care Professionals at Leeds Dental Institute and Health Education England, Yorkshire & Humber DCP Team.

Course content will address the specific role of the dental nurse in supporting patient care and engagement with other multi-disciplinary teams.

Underpinning knowledge about measuring and recording plaque is covered, together with application of fluoride varnish. These topic areas require a workplace mentor or witness to observe, feedback, and sign off a clinical reflective workbook.
